

§ 72.14 PARKING AFTER SNOWFALL.

It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be parked on any public street in the village at any time after not less than two inches of snow have fallen and accumulated on the street. Restriction on such parking shall remain in effect until snow removal operations have removed the snow from a Street, after which it is again available for parking. After such snowfall and accumulation, if any parked vehicle obstructs or prevents or interferes with snow removal operations being conducted by the village on any public street, on order of any Police Officer of the village, that vehicle may be towed from the public street. Such towed vehicle shall be stored on any village property or in any public garage or on a parking lot. The vehicle shall be restored to the owner or operator thereof only after payment of the reasonable expense incurred by the village in removing and storing such vehicle. Towing expense shall not exceed \$50 and storage charge shall not exceed \$5 per day. These charges are in addition to the fines hereinafter provided.

§ 72.15 TRAILERS AND SEMI-TRAILERS.

No trailer or semi-trailer shall be parked at any time on any street or public right-of-way unless connected to a vehicle capable of pulling or drawing such trailer or semi-trailer, and parked where legally permitted.

Additionally, the following Sections of the Itasca Public Works Codes will be enforced:

REFUSE. Combustible refuse, including but not limited to paper, cartons, boxes, barrels, wood, excelsior, wood furniture, bedding; noncombustible refuse, including, but not limited to metals, tin cans, metal furniture, glass, crockery, other mineral waste, street rubbish and ashes, residue from fires used for cooking and for heating buildings. Refuse shall not include earth and wastes from building operations, nor shall it include solid wastes resulting from industrial processes and manufacturing operations such as food processing wastes, boiler house cinders, lumber, scraps and shavings.

YARD WASTE. Accumulations of grass or shrubbery cuttings, leaves, tree limbs, and other materials accumulated as the result of the maintenance of lawns, gardens, shrubbery, vines and trees

§ 50.02 UNLAWFUL TO ALLOW GARBAGE TO ACCUMULATE.

It shall be unlawful to accumulate or keep garbage, trash, refuse or yard wastes on any premises longer than one week, or to dispose of same other than as provided herein.

§ 50.03 THROWING, DEPOSITING OF GARBAGE, TRASH, REFUSE AND YARD WASTE PROHIBITED; STORAGE OF CONTAINERS.

(A) It shall be unlawful to throw or deposit garbage, trash, refuse, and yard waste on any public or private property within the village, including retention/detention basins and creeks, whether occupied or unoccupied, except that the owner or person in control of property may
