

maintain private receptacles for garbage, trash, refuse and yard waste, which are waste products resulting from the occupancy of the property itself. Such receptacles shall comply with the provisions of this chapter and other provisions of this code and shall be placed and maintained in such a manner so that the garbage, trash, refuse and yard waste deposited within such receptacles shall not be carried, deposited, or wind blown upon any street, sidewalk, or other public place, or upon any private property.

(B) It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit garbage or refuse or garbage containers or boxes, or paper or plastic bags, or any metal container in any street, alley or public way except for a period from 4:00 p.m. before the day designated for collection and until 10:00 p.m. on the day of collection. At all other times the garbage or refuse of any kind or garbage containers or metal containers of any kind shall be stored in the rear of or inside the premises.

§ 50.07 COLLECTION.

The occupants of each dwelling unit shall dispose of garbage, trash and refuse by having same picked up not less than once a week from the public street or parkway nearest the dwelling unit by a scavenger service which is licensed and regulated by the Village.

§ 50.08 USE OF YARD WASTE PROGRAM.

(A) It is required of all owners of residential property, or persons in possession, not using a composting method, or other legal means of disposing of yard waste, to use the yard waste program adopted by the village, which has engaged in a commercial waste hauler to dispose of same, by which residents shall deposit the yard waste, separate from all other garbage, trash and refuse, and place in appropriate compostable paper bags (not to exceed 30-gallons capacity) and to which shall be affixed certain stickers or identifier tags, and placed at or near the Street curb of the property for pick-up. The Board of Trustees shall adopt procedures from time to time to implement the yard waste program.

(B) Nothing herein contained shall prevent the owner of property or person in possession from using a law service which collects and disposes of yard waste, to a place outside of the village.

§ 50.09 SCAVENGER SERVICE.

(A) The occupant of each dwelling unit shall pay to the village an established fee per month per dwelling unit for scavenger service. This charge shall be added to the monthly bill for water and sewer service and shall be included as a part of such bill.

(B) Nothing herein contained shall alter or affect the requirement that the occupant of each dwelling unit shall pay the village an established fee, on a regular basis, per dwelling unit, for scavenger circuit to pick-up garbage, trash and refuse.
